

TEEN LEARNING CENTER CONTRACT

At the *Teen Learning Center*, we choose to entrust our parental authority rights and personal preferences to another parent/teacher for a specific learning experience. By choosing to participate we realize that some guidelines must be in place for a successful year. Please read the following and review them with your teens/children. After reading, please sign the attached form, agreeing to your compliance of this contract and waiver of liability.

Any student found willfully not complying with TLC Guidelines, academically or behaviorally, will be reprimanded up to the point of temporary suspension or even expulsion from TLC.

STUDENTS:

1. Students are expected to treat classes, teachers and other students with integrity and accountability.
2. Students are to arrive with a cooperative and teachable spirit.
3. Students are to be prompt in arriving to class and in completing assignments.
4. Students will refrain from use of inappropriate language, verbal threats, or physical force (e.g. hitting, wrestling, karate kicking, etc.). Please be aware that any of the above may result in temporary suspension or even expulsion from TLC.
5. Students will be responsible for restitution for any damages they inflict to church property.

PARENTS:

1. Parents maintain the responsibility to follow up with the student's teacher(s) regarding special considerations, expected absences, or assignment changes.
2. Parents should take an active role in making sure their own children are compliant (clothing, respect in classes, assignments completed, etc.)
3. When you see a problem, be part of the solution.
4. Throughout the year, parents will need to review the course descriptions and weekly assignments for the purpose of reminding themselves of the expectations of the class and whether their teens/children are meeting those expectations.
5. Parents have the ultimate responsibility for determining grades and credits using the evaluations of the teacher(s).
6. Parents with students with learning disabilities and/or special challenges will need to confer with teacher(s) before classes begin. The parent should then understand specifically how (s)he will need to work with the student during the week so that he comes to class with assignments finished.
7. Parents must be in compliance with all North Carolina homeschooling laws.
8. Parents must belong to a CHEA sponsored organization in order to participate in TLC.
9. Parents maintain the ultimate responsibility for their teens/children. A parent is to be on site and all teens/children are to be supervised by an adult during the lunch period. Leaving to obtain a lunch is not permitted.
10. Parents are expected to set an example to the students by following the same rules themselves.
11. Parents will be responsible to assure their teens/children make restitution for damages to church property when applicable.
12. Because parents maintain the responsibility of their teens/children, neither TLC nor the church facility will be held liable in the unfortunate event of an accident.

ALL:

1. We will arrive 10 minutes before classes begin.
2. We will practice courtesy in our speech, behavior and attire.
3. We will show a Christ-like attitude toward one another.
4. We will show appreciation for the privilege of being guests of the church by treating the facilities with care and respect.
5. Failure to comply with this contract may result in losing the privilege to continue to participate in TLC.
